## The United Church in Meadowood Job Description - Camp Meadowood Coordinator 2024 (There are two positions)

The Camp Meadowood Coordinator is accountable to UCiM's Ministry & Personnel Committee. The position reports to and works within the policies of the Christian Education (CE) Committee and UCiM Board. The Camp Meadowood Coordinator works in concert with the Day Camp Director.

## Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership at UCiM's Camp Meadowood, which will be held from August 12<sup>th</sup> to August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Following the provided activity plan, the Camp Meadowood Coordinators will lead and / or assist the CE Coordinator in prepping and implementing the activities, games, crafts, and snacks throughout the week.
- Assist the Day Camp Coordinator with the planning of some activities, games and crafts for the
  afternoons.
- Participate in required training of youth leadership in advance of the camp.
- During the week of camp, the Camp Meadowood Coordinator will provide fun and engaging leadership for all the children attending.
- Supervise camp participants during activities, games, and quiet time.
- Assist the Day Camp Director with the supervision of youth helpers. (ie. Keeping youth helpers on-task, reminding youth helpers of their responsibilities, etc.)

- Previous experience in working with children would be an asset.
- A strong personal Christian faith.
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively.
- Good interpersonal skills and ability to interact with children aged 4 to 10 years old.
- Strong communication skills.
- Ability to be an innovative, empathetic and friendly leader with a keen sense of fun and

commitment to this ministry.
